

## PRIOR TO YOUR VISIT.

### CLEAR THE WAY.

Before we work our concrete wonders, please remove any furniture, decorations, plants, or other items from the area. Clearing the space will allow us to navigate freely and perform our sealing process efficiently.

### SWEEP AWAY THE OLD.

A clean canvas sets the stage for excellence. Grab a broom or a leaf blower and sweep away any loose dirt, leaves, or debris from the concrete surfaces. This will help us achieve a uniform and flawless seal

### TRIM THE GREENERY.

Before our concrete sealing extravaganza begins, let's take a moment to appreciate the beauty of nature and ensure it doesn't interfere with our process. If you have any overhanging branches or plants encroaching upon the concrete surface, we kindly ask you to give them a little trim. By cutting back any overhang or plants, we can create a clear path for our team to work their magic and ensure a flawless seal.

### DRYNESS IS KEY.

We want to ensure optimal adhesion and longevity of the sealer. Please make sure the concrete surfaces are dry before our arrival. If you or your neighbours have automated irrigation, please be mindful to turn these off.







## DAY ONE.

### CLEANING & PREPARATION.

On day one, we'll perform a deep cleanse of your concrete surfaces to make them sparkle like never before. But here's where you come in to ensure the best results:

### LET IT FLOW.

We'll need access to your taps for our trusty pressure washers to do their thing. Let the water flow, and we'll take care of the rest!

### STAY CLEAR.

During the drying phase, minimize usage of the cleaned and prepared surfaces, allowing them to dry fully. This will keep things squeaky clean and help the concrete prepare for its sealing debut.

## CONES AND TAPE, OH MY!

After our cleaning extravaganza, we'll put up cones and tape to make sure everyone knows your driveway is off-limits. They'll stay in place for a minimum of twelve hours after sealing, so keep the party away until then. If you can, it's even better to give the sealer a full twenty-four hours to settle.











# DAY TWO.

### SEALING.

Get ready for the grand finale! On day two, our team will swoop in to apply our Prime Premium Concrete Sealer. It's the icing on the cake, but we need your help:

## NO DANCING SHOES (YET).

## TIMING IS EVERYTHING.


We'll be washing and sealing between the hours of 7 am and 3 pm. It's the perfect window to let our expertise shine and take advantage of the cooler hours of the day.

## TENDER LOVING CARE.

Treat your sealed surfaces with care. Avoid dragging heavy objects or using sharp tools that could scratch or damage the sealer. A little extra caution goes a long way! When it's time to clean, opt for mild, non-abrasive cleaners specifically formulated for sealed surfaces. Avoid harsh chemicals or abrasive scrubbing or pressure washing that might compromise the sealer's integrity. A gentle touch will do wonders!

### SHIELD FROM THE ELEMENTS.

Whenever possible, provide protection from extreme weather conditions. With our harsh winters, consider using a snow shovel with a plastic blade to minimize potential damage to the sealer.

## RE-SEALING RENDEZVOUS.

Over time, your sealed concrete surfaces will naturally undergo changes. Factors like UV exposure, foot traffic, and the elements we experience in the Okanagan contribute to this evolution. While the initial shine may diminish, rest assured that the sealer's primary purpose of protecting your concrete remains intact. It continues to provide enhanced durability and resistance to stains and weathering.
